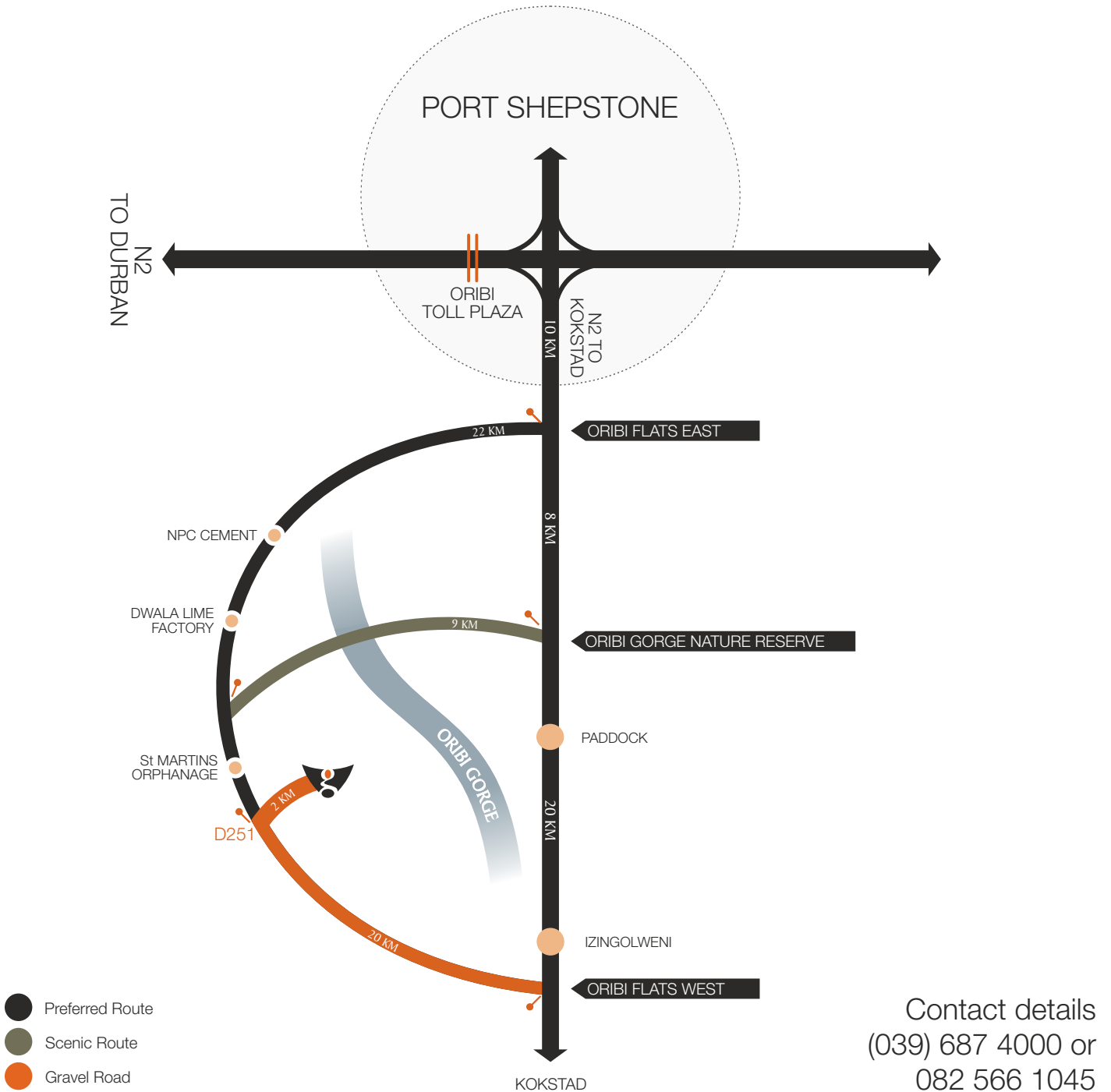

## GETTING TO THE GORGE

### **Travelling from Durban on the N2 South towards Port Shepstone**

#### **Preferred route:**

- From Durban travel on the N2 south towards Port Shepstone for approx. 60 min
- At the Oribi Toll Plaza take the far left off-ramp (Marburg; Harding; Kokstad)
- At the top of the off-ramp turn right and travel for 10km towards Harding/Kokstad
- Turn right at the Oribi Flats East sign (large intersection with robot)
- Drive for 22km past the NPC Cement factory, past the old Oribi Gorge Hotel
- Proceed past Leopard Rock, past the big T junction, past St Martin's Orphanage
- Proceed down the hill and turn left onto district road D251 (a gravel road)
- Continue on the D251 for 2km and turn left into our gate - The Gorge

#### **Scenic route:**

- Travel on the N2 south towards Port Shepstone for approximately 60 min
- At the Oribi Toll Plaza take the far left off-ramp (Marburg; Harding; Kokstad)
- At the top of the off-ramp turn right and travel for 18km towards Harding/Kokstad
- Turn right at the Oribi Gorge Nature Reserve sign (opposite Coastal Farmers)
- Drive through the scenic gorge for 9km (a tarred road, very narrow)
- At the T-junction turn left and continue past St Martin's Orphanage
- Proceed down the hill and turn left onto the district road D251 (a gravel road)
- Continue on the D251 for 2km and turn left into our gate - The Gorge

### **Travelling from the Eastern Cape on the N2 via Kokstad & Harding**

#### **Scenic route - Through the Oribi Gorge Nature Reserve:**

- Stay on the N2 East, 19km after Ezingolweni look out for Plains
- Turn left at the Oribi Gorge Nature Reserve sign (at Plains, opposite Coastal Farmers)
- Drive through the scenic gorge for 9km (a narrow tarred road)
- At the T-junction turn left and continue past St Martin's Orphanage
- Proceed down the hill and turn left onto the district road D251 (a gravel road)
- Continue on the D251 for 2km and turn left into our gate - The Gorge

#### **GPS co-ordinates**

- 30° 41' 58" S and 30° 12' 35" E
